

Registration of Non-Type Certified (non-TC) UAS

2. Registration of Non-Type Certified (non-TC) UAS has been temporarily suspended until further notice. For registration of locally manufactured non-TC UAS in India (Nano/Model; under Rule 13), applicants may contact DGCA at **drone.dgca@gov.in** with the following duly filled, signed and stamped, as applicable:-

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(iii) Details of MSN, FCM, and RPS of the UAS to be registered.

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(iv) Images (compressed) of UAS front View, Top view, and Close-up of manufacturer's serial number."

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(v) Copy of Import authorization issued by DGFT & copy of bill (*in case, NOT manufactured in INDIA*).

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DECLARATION

(a). I hereby declare that our **Model UAS will not be used for any commercial activity**.

(b). I will ensure that all R&D operations are conducted in VLOS conditions and within Green Zone areas under our control.

(c). For UAS activities in Yellow or Red Zones, necessary permissions/ exemptions will be obtained from the concerned ATC and Ministry of Civil Aviation, respectively.

(d). Where UAS being used for R&D purposes, an activity report at least once in every two months, or as requested by DGCA or MoCA, whichever is earlier, will be submitted. All data and insights generated from these operations shall be retained and will be provided to DGCA, whenever required.

(e). Notwithstanding the above, in case of any accident/ incident involving UAS, same will be reported to DGCA immediately.

(f). I will initiate the Type Certification process for the submitted model UAS concurrently to enable future commercial operations in line with the Drone Rules, 2021.

(g). I hereby declare that all information provided herein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I understand that furnishing any false information herein shall make me liable for penal action, as applicable.
